- When you get injured at work, report to the First Aider immediately, and they will escort you to the medical clinic for assessment, if required.

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Key Responsibilities:

- WCB Injury/Illness Case Management:
- Assist employees with navigating their WCB claim
- Injury management, rehabilitation, & return-to-work planning
- Workplace Injury Assessment & Treatment:
- When you get injured at work, report to the First Aider immediately, and they will escort you to the medical clinic for assessment, if required.
- Health Surveillance:
- Health screening for early identification of work-related & non-work-related illness.
- Health & Wellness Program Development:



- Health education programs, workplace wellness initiatives, and communicable disease prevention programs, and employee health and well-being advice & support.

Non-Occupational Injury/Illness Case Management:

This process involves Human resources and management.

- Support employees with medical management, rehabilitation, & return-to-work planning after an absence due to illness or surgery that is not work-related (e.g., knee replacement, back surgery, mental health leave)
